

### "SAINT CYRIL AND METHODIUS - SLAVIC APOSTOLES"



Historical drama for the great Slavic educators and equal to the apostles "St. Cyril and St. Methodius". The film focuses on the main arival of Saints Constantine and Methodius, the priestly preacher Eiben, who discreetly pulls the strings, acting as a double agent and a medieval lobbyist. At the heart of the film's message is that Europe and European countries will not be saved by economic power with their

heritage, they can only survive here if they nurture the same moral and spiritual values. The film also deals with the epic battle of Veligrad.

Nominated for the highest film award Czech Lion, Febio-Slovakia, festivals in Russia and others.



Viktor Krištof, producer of the film "Saints Cyril and Methodius - Slavic Apostles", is the youngest member of the family production company, Three Brothers from the Czech Republic, founded by brothers Vladimir, Boris and Igor Kristof in 1991. Their specialty is historical films and effects. Produced about 90 feature and documentary films, independently or with huge TV companies, such as ZDF, ARTE, BBC and others. He also worked on numerous interna-

tional and Hollywood films, including Joan of Arc, Henry IV, The Trinity Musketeers... He collaborated with the actors Arnold Schwarzenegger, Sean Connery and others. Producer of the films Jan Hus, Musicians, Letters from Prague and many others.

## "MANAKI - A STORY IN PICTURES"







The documentary "Manaki - A Story in Pictures" is a work that talks about the personal history of the Manaki brothers, but it is even more important that it speaks with artifacts about the photographic and cinematographic history of Macedonia. The author researched six years in several countries (Macedonia, Greece, Serbia, Bulgaria, Romania and France) and came across information that is presented for the first time in this film! Every fact and opinion presented in the film has been carefully re-

searched and confirmed with presented artifacts.

The film won the Best Documentary Award at the SEE a Paris Film Festival in Southeast Europe, at the SEE Online Film Festival was named best documentary. It was shown at the First UNESCO Forum of Film Cities in Bitola. It was also shown in Sofia, Novi Sad and Belgrade, Lodz in Poland, and in 15 Balkan cities, as part of the Balkanofilmophilia festival. Closing ceremony of the 40th ICFF "Manaki Brothers" in 2019 was for the first time with documentary film "Manaki brothers"!



# "THROUGH THE EYES OF THE PHOTOGRAPHER"





The incredibly energetic 88-year-old popular Slovak photographer Zuzana Minacova has had a huge impact on Czech and Slovak photography for over 50 years, exhibiting in over thirty countries around the world. This successful and extremely positive woman is haunted by the secret of her childhood that

torments her and does not allow her to sleep. The only solution is to discover the great childhood love between her, a Jewish girl and a Christian boy, Peter. An incredibly difficult journey begins. She visits Auschwitz again, a concentration camp where 70 years ago she experienced the most horrible moments of her life. Will she finally find peace and leave the past behind?

Today, her photos of Robert De Niro, Sharon Stone, Michael Douglas, Antonio Banderas and many other stars are legendary in the world cinematography. The film has won awards at more than 70 international festivals, in New York-USA, Karlovy Vary-Czech Republic, Warsaw-Poland, Haifa-Israel and others.







# "OSTROG FROM ROVCA"



Monastery Kostrikovaca is hidden in miraculous nature along the canyon of the river Mrtvica, in Montenegro. May be the last film shot of the late Metropolitan Amfilohije Radović, which speaks of his family's attachment to this monastery, gives a special stamp to the film.

The film has been screened at the "Vigil of the Soul", Festival in Serbia, at 5 festivals in Russia, at a festival in Ukraine, and has won 3 awards. The international premiere was this year in Moscow. It is shown for the first time in Macedonian and English at the festival "Holy Virgin Mary Omophorion".



### "TUMANE MONASTERY - TESTIMONIES"



The film shows numerous testimonies about the healings of the believers who visited this shrine. The monastery is visited by people from all over the world, regardless of religion and nationality, seeking help and salvation. It is located 12 km from Golubac and is dedicated to the Holy Archangel Gabriel.

The main protagonist of the documentary is the abbot of the monastery Dimitrij, who testifies about numerous healings. The film also shows the secret of the Tuman saints

Saint Zosimus and Saint James. The film was awarded at the Nis Film Festival and screened at the Mostar Film Festival. It is shown for the first time in Macedonian and English at the "Holy Virgin Mary Omophorion" festival.



Closing of the festival with an international premiere of the Czech feature film Comenius, dedicated to Jan Amos Komensky, who lives in the late 16th and early 17th centuries, in a time of hatred between Catholics and Protestants. He is not only a pedagogue, but also a writer, scien-

tist, philosopher, theologian, bishop of the Czech Brotherhood and lives a spiritually ascetic life. He is under strong impressions of Francis Bacon, Jean-Jacques Rousseau, Pestalozzi, Jan Huss. Komensky is an example with his life of everything that is spiritual, sublime, but also of the suffering and the humane. A great movie that we highly recommend!




### "WHO IS COMENIUS AND HOW WAS THE MOVIE MADE?"



The film has its World premiere at the "Holy Virgin Mary Omophorion" festival. Part of the interview is Pavel Kopp, who was awarded this year for Best Director of Photography in Los Angeles. They answer the questions of the students of the "European University" from Skopje and the students from the primary school "Jan Amos Komenski" from Skopje. Otherwise, the European University established a traditional award to award the most valuable volunteer of the festival a free four-year scholarship, in honor of the late founder of this University, Bojo Andreski.



Bogorodicen pokrov: According to the data from your site, in 2019th, you had 100.000 visitors at 700 events in 418 vanues. How was that possible for three spiritual women? To you Márta Dragonits, to Ildikó Kolek and Ilona Toroczkay, who although are three of you, you are like the same soul and founders of this festival

Dr. Márta Dragonits: I don't think we achieved that, we gave only our five breads and our two fish. We made a great poster, which said: "Our

main Sponsor is the Holy Spirit":) Following our call, more and more people joined us, to organize the Festival. Among others we work together with the organizers of the European Heritage Days, since most of the European cultural heritage is sacral. The European culture has grown out of Jewish - Christian faith, the roots of it's civilization are there.
